

CHART SHOWING INTESTATE SUCCESSION OF HEIRS (OTHER THAN SURVIVING SPOUSE) AND DEGREES OF RELATIONSHIP

(Note that succession does not extend to great grandparents or their issue)

A surviving spouse inherits the entire intestate estate unless the decedent also left children from a prior marriage. If there are children from a prior marriage, those children share in the decedent's Estate. Refer to A.R.S. Section 14-2102 for more information about the intestate shares apportioned between a surviving spouse and the decedent's children who are not children of the surviving spouse.
